If you are a teacher submitting your student/s' work, please follow the instructions below:

1. Go to <https://akivaschool.artcall.org>
2. At this point, you will be able to create ONE username and password.
3. You will receive an email confirming your registration.
4. You will have an opportunity to submit up to 100 submissions under YOUR username.
5. Once you have submitted all of your student/s' work, you will receive an email indicating all of the submissions that have been successfully inputted and will receive a follow up email at the conclusion of the contest should one of your children be a winner.

Please note: ALL children will receive certificates of participation from Akiva School that will be mailed directly to your school for distribution.

If you are a parent or guardian submitting your child's work, please follow the instructions below:

2. At this point, you will be able to create a username and password.
3. If you are submitting for multiple children at a time, you may create ONE username and password that will suffice for all submissions.
3. You will receive an email confirming your registration.
4. You will have an opportunity to submit up to 100 submissions under YOUR username.
5. Once you have submitted your child/children's work, you will receive an email indicating all of the submissions that have been successfully inputted and will receive a follow up email at the conclusion of the contest should one of your children be a winner.
